Important specifics for lesson #1:

- 1. Call attendance. Make sure all the students present are enrolled in the class. In case one of the students is not enrolled, ask a school supervisor to take the necessary actions.
- 2. A student who is not enrolled WILL NOT be able to take the car home.
- 3. Take 2 to 3 minutes to really try and memorize the kids' names.
- 4. Present yourselves and the class (see file lesson introduction attached)
- 5. Start building the car. Make sure to give specific safety instructions, and make sure all students understand them.
- 6. Completely finish building the car. The students' cars should be operating and intact.
- 7. Go through each car with a set of batteries and make sure the cars are properly operating. No student may turn on their car in class.
- 8. Explain to the students that, when operating the car at home, they should put a pillow or stand in front of the car so it doesn't hit the wall.
- 9. Tell the students we will be starting a big project next week.
- 10. If the class is not full, you may ask the kids to invite their friends to join class. Their friends who join will also receive a car.
- 11. Let the kids take home their cars without batteries!
