

Balsa Glider- Lesson Plan



Paint the body, using markers only.

Make sure you have enough time to paint the model, and finishing its assembly.

Pop the parts carefully, they are extremely fragile



After coloring all the parts, Insert the wings to their rightful place. Look at the cracks on the wing to identify the center.



Hand every kid, 2 shark heads (as shown in the picture)



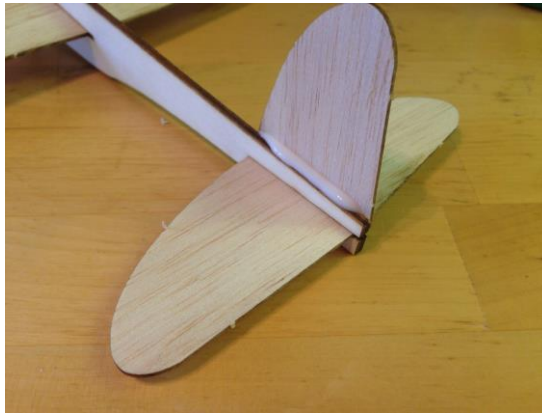
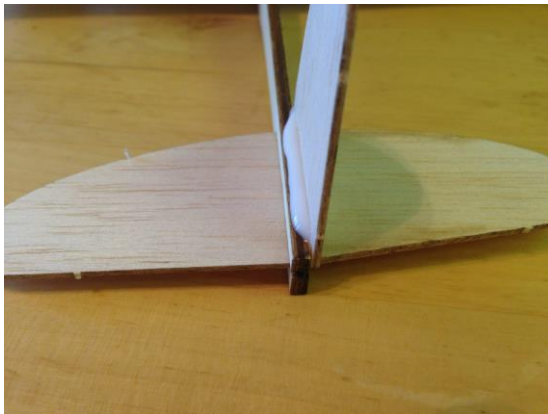
Place one shark head on each of the body's sides. Align the holes and insert a gold paper fastener.



Take out his part, and slide it into the back crack of the glider



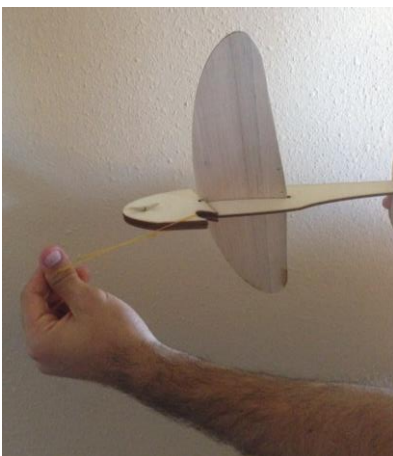
This is the only part we glue, look at the photos below to see the directions



Part number one inserted from the back, and part number two is glued on top of that.



This is the completed model.



Give the kids safety instruction before operating the glider.

Place the rubber band under the glider. Hold the rubber band with you thumb. Pull the glider towards your shoulder (not too much or else the band will rip). Aim the glider 45 degrees up, and release.
